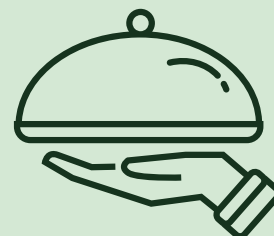
Through careful categorisation of waste, active monitoring,
